

Submission Guidelines

- Accepting Submissions Jan 1, 2023 through April 1, 2023.
- Submit up to five prose poems
- Submissions should be blind, not showing the author's name anywhere. (That information is entered separately on Submittable)
- Reading fee, \$8. (Goes toward prize monies and production costs. Winning unsolicited work receives a \$200 prize and the two runners-up each receive \$100.)
- Proposed publication date for the anthology is January 2024.
